

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 24 September 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We visited and found that the provider had failed to notify us about a significant event. This is a breach of requirement and this is the second time that the provider has breached this requirement. However, the provider is now clear about their responsibility to notify Ofsted of such events in the future. As a result, we took no further action in respect of this breach. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
