## Summary of key findings

### This provision meets requirements

- The manager has a secure knowledge and comprehension of safeguarding procedures. She prioritises children's safety and ensures that her team understands its responsibilities through the use of regular training and team discussions. She explains how she would record and report any concerns, including how she would respond to any allegations made.
- The manager understands the importance of establishing effective relationships with the host school. She discusses how she plans activities that reflect children's individual interests and complement what they are learning at school.
- The manager explains how her staff team promotes the importance of healthy lifestyles. She details how children are afforded fresh air and exercise and how they are provided with healthy snacks and drinks.
- The manager demonstrates through discussion how her staff team uses a consistent approach to manage children's behaviour in a positive way. She explains the gentle and consistent reminders that staff use to help children understand what is expected of them and to learn right from wrong. She understands the importance of developing children's independence during activities and routines.
- The manager is aware of the importance of self-evaluation and explains how she captures the views of children. Parents and staff inform and drive forward improvements that have a positive impact on the service she provides.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
