

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 11 November 2019, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 12 November 2019 we visited the setting and found that the provider had taken steps to address the issue. On the 15 November 2019 they notified us of further action they were taking to address issues related to the suitability of the premises. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage'.

On 4 February 2020 we completed a further visit. We are satisfied with the steps the provider has taken.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
