Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the procedures to report any concerns or allegations to the relevant authorities. She has a clear understanding of her role and responsibility to safeguard children.
- The childminder understands how to reflect on the quality of her practice to identify areas for further development. She recognises the need to continue to improve her skills and knowledge.
- The childminder understands the importance of assessing children's progress and of planning for what they need to learn next. She knows how to plan activities for children of all ages, to help support their learning needs.
- The childminder understands the importance of working with parents and other professionals in children's lives, to help support children's development and care needs.
- The childminder has a range of suitable resources for children of all age ranges. She understands the importance of helping children learn to manage their feelings, to help them to develop good behaviour and positive attitudes to learning.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
