Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands her role to keep children safe and promote their well-being at all times. She knows the procedures to follow if she has any concerns about a child's welfare. The childminder attends regular training to keep her skills and knowledge current.
- The childminder knows how to support children's learning and development. She has a good range of resources for children to play with and to help them learn. The childminder knows how to plan activities and experiences to help children acquire the skills and knowledge they need to move on to the next stage in their education. The childminder understands how to work with parents and other professionals involved with children to ensure high levels of consistency for children's care and learning.
- The childminder knows how to support children's emotional development. She understands how to promote positive behaviour, using strategies such as simple house rules. The childminder understands how to support children to develop a healthy and active lifestyle. She recognises the importance of providing children with opportunities to learn about diversity in the wider world.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
