## Summary of key findings

### This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the importance of planning a wide range of activities and experiences for children to help them progress in their learning and development. She has suitable systems in place to assess children's development and knows how to support children's learning through play.
- The childminder recognises the importance of promoting good behaviour, kindness and respect for others to support children's personal development and their welfare. She knows how to promote healthy lifestyles for children within her setting, including providing nutritious food and plenty of exercise outdoors.
- The childminder is aware of the need to evaluate her practice and develop her skills. She understands the importance of keeping her knowledge up to date. The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents. She knows to update parents with regular feedback about children's progress and care.
- The childminder understands how to help safeguard children and knows the steps to follow if she has any concerns about children's welfare. She knows it is important to maintain a safe environment.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
