

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2</u>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 January 2020 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We held a telephone interview with the provider to discuss the concerns and have issued a Notice to Improve. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action required;

Risk assessment

3.64 ensure that a risk assessment is carried out and appropriate action taken for all outings including, drop of and collection to and from each school. - By 28 Feb 2020

ensure that children's behaviour is managed in a suitable manner at all times. - By 28 Feb 2020
