

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 25 July 2019 we inspected the provider and found they were not meeting some of these requirements. We served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed:

ensure records of accidents occurring on the premises are accurate by 26 September 2019

implement an effective and consistent key person system so that children benefit from secure care and learning experiences by 26 September 2019

ensure children are provided with food that adheres to their specific dietary requirements and/or allergies by 26 September 2019

ensure staff are provided with induction training to help them understand their roles and responsibilities by 26 September 2019

We decided to take steps to cancel the provider's registration. However, the provider decided to resign their registration before we could complete this step. The provider is no longer registered with Ofsted.
