

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All providers must meet the legal requirements in the childcare register, which you can find at www.gov.uk/guidance/childminders-and-childcare-providers-register-with-ofsted/registration-requirements.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. We carried out an unannounced inspection on 6 March to see whether the provider was meeting the requirements. During the inspection we found that this provider was not meeting the requirements and she does not demonstrate the capacity to make or sustain improvements. We are taking steps to cancel the provider's registration. The provider has a right to object to our intention to take this step. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
