### The school meets all of the national minimum standards that were checked during this inspection

### **Context of the inspection**

The school was inspected on 30 April 2019 to 1 May 2019. It was judged to be good, with three breaches of the national minimum standards (NMS). This monitoring visit was conducted to assess the provider's progress in meeting NMS 11, due to the action plan lacking sufficient detail.

### Summary of the progress made in implementing the action plan

Leaders have undertaken a review of the school's safeguarding and child protection policies. The revised documents are in line with the host authority's (West Sussex) guidance. Furthermore, the designated safeguarding lead (DSL) and the deputy DSL have met with the local multi-agency safeguarding hub (MASH). Records of this meeting were sampled, and these demonstrate that the DSLs have a clear understanding of the safeguarding referral process and have improved their professional links with the host authority.

The DSLs have both attended recent safeguarding training and seminars. They have demonstrated the impact of this training by making relevant referrals and seeking consultation from the MASH team regarding safeguarding matters. The headmaster has also commissioned the Boarding Schools Association (BSA) to undertake an audit of the safeguarding policies and procedures to further satisfy themselves that the recent changes are effective.

A trustee attended a conference in September 2019 to enhance their safeguarding understanding. Consequently, their next report had a greater focus on safeguarding. The quality of the trustee reports will be further assessed by the BSA safeguarding audit.

The Rikkyo School in England was first established in 1972 and is situated on the West Sussex/Surrey border, close to the village of Rudgwick. Rikkyo is an independent, coeducational school acknowledged by the Department of Education in Japan. All the boarding accommodation is located within the school grounds. At the time of the inspection, there were 169 students boarding at the school. The boarding provision was last inspected in May 2019.
