

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

'All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 16 June 2020 we carried out a regulatory telephone call to the childminder, following a notification to Ofsted from the provider. We have served a notice to improve outcome following the regulatory call. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed:

improve knowledge and understanding of child protection policies and legislation, including 'Working Together to Safeguard Children 2015' to keep children and their families safe, 23 June 2020

gain a thorough understanding of events/ changes that must be notified to Ofsted, 23 June 2020

The provider responded to the notice and demonstrated that they have taken action to meet the requirements.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.



We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
