

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 March 2020, the provider notified us that a child had left the setting unsupervised. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of any significant event likely to affect the suitability of the provider.

We found that the provider had breached the early years foundation stage welfare requirements in relation to staff:child ratios in particular children were not being adequately supervised. Risk assessments, as all reasonable steps were not being taken to ensure that children were not exposed to risks and Premises, reasonable steps were not in place to ensure that children do not leave the premises unsupervised.

The provider has now taken action to comply with the requirements of the early years foundation stage welfare requirements.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services



we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
