

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early year's foundation stage, which you can find at https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 26 February 2020, we received information that raised concerns that the childminder had not notified Ofsted, within 14 days, of changes to persons living in the household, and a significant event.

We discussed this information with the childminder, who acknowledged she had not notify Ofsted as she is required to do. The childminder confirmed she now understands the statutory requirements regarding matters she should notify to Ofsted and will do so in future.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
