

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 12 February 2020 we carried out an inspection of this provider, the outcome of which was judged to be inadequate with enforcement. We have served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed:

ensure that all staff have a robust knowledge and understanding of safeguarding procedures and know how to respond appropriately if an allegation of abuse is made against a member of staff

ensure that children who require additional help are supported fully to promote their development

take all reasonable steps to make sure children are not exposed to risks, and demonstrate how these risks are managed, with particular regard to the use of raw jelly in children's play activities

ensure that all staff have a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities so that they can support children's learning and welfare effectively

ensure all staff receive induction training that helps them to understand their roles and responsibilities and includes information about safeguarding and child protection

ensure the setting's recruitment procedure is followed robustly to ensure all staff are suitable for their role

by 19 March 2020.

A visit was completed on 20 July 2020 and it was established that the actions have been met.
