

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-</u><u>foundation-stage-framework--2</u>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 July 2020, the provider notified us of a significant event. This notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 31 July 2020, we discussed the concerns with the provider who conducted an internal investigation.

We found that the provider had taken prompt and effective action to prevent a reoccurrence. The action taken was to:

ensure staff were alert to any issues of concern in the child's life at home or elsewhere, and that staff implement the child protection policy and procedures effectively. Refresher training was immediately implemented (Child protection, Safeguarding).

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and no further action was required by Ofsted on this matter. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
