

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 2 October 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We inspected on 14 October 2019 and issued a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. We visited the provider on 3 December 2019 and although they had taken some action to address the initial breach of requirements, we issued another welfare requirements notice.

Actions needed by 16 December 2019

ensure documentation relating to children's accidents contains information about any injuries sustained by the child

ensure medication is stored securely and out of children's reach at all times.

We visited on 21 December 2019 and found the provider had completed the actions within the time scale. They remain registered with Ofsted.
