

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 17 March 2020, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. As a result of these concerns, the provider liaised with other statutory agencies and took action to meet their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements. Ofsted is satisfied with the action taken by the provider.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
