

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 September 2020 we received concerns that the childminder was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 4 September 2020 we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the childminder was not meeting some of the requirements and has taken action to put this right. We found the childminder had improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures. This was in relation to the action to take if an allegation is made against the childminder or a person living/working on the premises.

The provider will be able to given parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
