

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

'All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 10 August the provider informed us of a significant event. We visited the nursery on 21 August and found that not all of the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' requirements were being met. We have issued a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.'

- 3.9 ensure that people looking after children are suitable to fulfil the requirement of their roles by 9 September 2020
- 3.12 record information about staff qualifications and the identity checks and vetting processes that have been completed by 9 September 2020.

A further visit took place on 10 September to monitor compliance with the notice. The provider is meeting requirements.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
