

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2</u>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 31 July 2020 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We contacted the setting on 1 September 2020 and found that not all of the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' requirements were being met. We issued a notice to improve, which asks the provider to take the action below. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider has taken appropriate steps in response to the action. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

3.4 ensure that all staff are fully aware of the action to be taken in the event of an allegation being made against a member of staff by 16 September 2020.
