

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On the 4 September 2020 we received a notification from the provider in relation to a unexplained injury to a child. We undertook a unannounced regulatory visit on the 15 September 2020. We have served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 1 October 2020:

put appropriate arrangements in place to ensure all children are adequately supervised and staffing arrangements meet their needs

implement an effective key-person system so that each key person fulfils their role in ensuring that each child's care is tailored to meet their individual needs, offer a settled relationship for the child and build a relationship with parents

make sure all staff have appropriate training, skills and knowledge, to help them have a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities.

On 2 October 2020, we conducted an unannounced regulatory call and found that the provider had taken appropriate action to meet the actions raised.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
