

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 7 November 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We visited the provider and found that they had not informed us of changes to the management committee. The provider has reassured us that they are now aware to keep Ofsted informed of any such changes.

The provider has subsequently not provided the information Ofsted requires to complete suitability checks for the new committee members. We have served an action. This notice requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action needed:

ensure effective systems are in place to enable completion of suitability checks for new members of the committee. In particular, provide information to Ofsted regarding committee members to enable suitability checks to be completed. To be completed by 28 August 2020.

A suitable response to the action has now been received, as all information has now been provided to Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
