## Main inspection findings

Part 3. Welfare, health and safety of pupils

Paragraphs 7, 7(a), 7(b), 32(1), 32(1)(c)

- The proprietor has ensured that safeguarding arrangements are fit for purpose. The safeguarding policy is detailed and pays due regard to the most up-to-date guidance from the Secretary of State. The policy is implemented effectively.
- Staff receive frequent training to ensure they are knowledgeable and kept up to date with the most recent guidelines.
- Systems to record concerns and subsequent actions are in place. Staff follow these procedures closely and records are kept meticulously.
- Leaders and staff are knowledgeable about how to follow up any concerns they may have about the safeguarding and welfare of pupils. Consequently, appropriate actions are taken swiftly when concerns arise. Information is shared with appropriate authorities and parents and carers to help promote pupils' well-being and safety.
- At the start of the inspection, the safeguarding policy published on the school website did not reflect the most up-to-date version that was in operation in the school. This administrative error was swiftly rectified by leaders.
- The standards relating to welfare, health and safety that were checked as part of this inspection are met.

### Part 8. Quality of leadership in and management of schools

Paragraph 34, 34(a), 34(b), 34(c)

- The proprietor has ensured that the standards checked as part of this inspection are met. The proprietor and leaders demonstrate a secure knowledge of the independent school standards and appropriate safeguarding procedures.
- The headteacher has implemented many new policies relating to child protection and wider aspects of safeguarding since her appointment in February 2020. Clear and appropriate policies for the use of the school's CCTV systems have been put into place. These promote the safe storage and disposal of any recorded images. The



- procedures for staff's use of two-way radios have been implemented. All staff have received training in how to use these appropriately to help keep pupils safe.
- Leaders have established clear and transparent systems that hold staff to account for their actions. Any concerns identified by leaders are recorded in detail. These are shared with staff as part of new performance management and supervision procedures. Appropriate action is taken if staff fall short of leaders' expectations.
- The proprietor has strengthened the governance of the school by recruiting parents. Minutes of governing body meetings are clear and detailed and show that governors undertake appropriate training from national associations. Governors make use of this training and their own professional skills to hold leaders to account for their actions.
- The standards relating to leadership and management are met.

- The DfE requested that the inspector report on the independent school standards in respect of the school's welfare, health and safety for pupils and leadership and management. In particular, the inspector focused on the arrangements to safeguard and promote the welfare of pupils.
- The inspector held discussions with the headteacher and the chief executive of the proprietor company, who is also chair of the governing body. The inspector had a telephone conversation with a virtual headteacher of a local authority that has placed pupils in the school.
- The inspector scrutinised a range of school documents relating to the organisation of the school, leadership and management and safeguarding.
