

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework.</u> If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 27 November 2020, we received a concern. We contacted the setting and found a significant event had occurred. On this occasion we do not intend to take any action. This is because at the time of the incident the provider took immediate action. They reviewed the quality of their risk assessment procedures and improved staff's understanding of health and safety. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
