

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 15 October 2020, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 13 November 2020:

- improve risk assessment procedures to ensure that staff act swiftly to remove identified hazards when children transition to different parts of the premises
  
- ensure that risk assessments sufficiently identify risks to children using outdoor equipment and that robust precautions are in place to minimise risk of injury to children should they fall on any hard surfaces
  
- ensure that staff are deployed effectively so that the needs of all children are met and they are adequately supervised at all times when outdoors
  
- promote good standards of hygiene across the nursery, especially in relation to toileting and potty training
  
- take steps to ensure that unauthorised adults cannot access the nursery when children are on the premises.

We monitored the provider's response and found that the provider has taken appropriate action and reviewed: staffing arrangements during outdoor activities, risk assessments including the security of the premises, arrangements for toileting and potty training and

installed new play surfaces.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
