

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Her Majesty's Chief Inspector of Education, Children's Services and Skills is leading Ofsted's work into how regulated early years and childcare providers in England have delivered child-centred practice and care, within the context of the restrictions placed on society during the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic.

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 January 2021, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 28 January 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 16 February 2021

ensure the committee returns all required documentation for Ofsted to check its suitability

provide effective supervision for managers so that they receive the support, coaching and training they need to develop a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities

ensure the committee and managers fully understand and implement the Local Safeguarding Children Partnership Arrangements, in particular the procedure to follow in the event of an allegation being made against a member of staff.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider.
