Overall outcome

The school does not meet all of the independent school standards that were checked during this inspection

Main inspection findings

Part 3. Welfare, health and safety of pupils

Paragraph 7, 7(a), 7(b), 16, 16(a), 16(b), 32(1)(c)

- At the monitoring inspection in September 2020, these standards were not met because the child protection and safeguarding policy referenced the September 2018 version of 'Keeping children safe in education'. The policy had not been updated with the 2019 and 2020 statutory guidance. Furthermore, the school's overall risk assessment policy was dated August 2019 and did not take account of issues relating to COVID-19 (coronavirus). In addition to this, the residential trip to Llandudno in July 2020 did not follow government guidance and consequently put pupils at risk.
- Leaders have updated the child protection and safeguarding policy to take account of current government requirements. There is an addendum to the policy to reflect the impact of COVID-19 on child protection and safeguarding. Leaders with designated responsibility for safeguarding are up to date with the latest training. Leaders ensure that all staff receive regular safeguarding training in person and online. Both leaders and staff know whom to report concerns to within the school and at the local authority. Pupils said that they feel safe in school. They know whom to report concerns to and they said that they are listened to. The safeguarding policy is available to parents and carers on request.
- Leaders have updated the risk assessment policy and they have also undertaken a COVID-19 risk assessment. Leaders considered the risks for those pupils returning to school in March 2021 and for those learning remotely. Leaders have implemented measures to mitigate these risks.
- The school now meets the requirements of the independent school standards in this part.



Part 8. Quality of leadership in and management of schools *Paragraph 34(1), 34(1)(a), 34(1)(b), 34(1)(c)*

- In the past three inspections in 2018, 2019 and 2020, leaders have not ensured that all the independent school standards have been met. The report of the inspection in April 2019 acknowledged the improvements made in relation to some of the standards. However, this report also identified some standards that remained unmet.
- The inspection in September 2020 identified that previously met standards relating to safeguarding and risk assessment were unmet.
- Leaders are not ensuring that they are consistently meeting the independent school standards.
- Leaders have now ensured that the standards regarding the welfare, health and safety of pupils are met.
- The school does not meet all the requirements of the independent school standards in this part.



Compliance with regulatory requirements

The school does not meet the requirements of the schedule to the Education (Independent School Standards) Regulations 2014 ('the independent school standards') and associated requirements that were checked during this inspection, as set out in the annex of this report. This included the standards and requirements that the school was judged to not comply with at the previous inspection. Not all of the standards and associated requirements were checked during this inspection.

Information about this school

- Beis Medrash Elyon is based in north-west London and is registered to admit up to 100 boys between the ages of 11 and 16 years.
- The school was judged to be inadequate in June 2018. It did not meet all the independent school standards that were checked at its last two progress monitoring inspections in April 2019 and September 2020.
- All pupils are from Orthodox Jewish backgrounds.



- There are no pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities, or education, health and care plans.
- The school does not use any alternative provision.
- The school is led by two headteachers, one responsible for the 'Kodesh' (religious) curriculum and the other for 'Chol' (secular) studies.
- A governing body oversees the school's strategic leadership.
- The school does not have a website, but all the required policies are available to parents on request.



Information about this inspection

- This inspection was carried out at the request of the registration authority for independent schools. The purpose of the inspection was to monitor the progress the school has made in meeting the independent school standards and other requirements that it was judged to not comply with at its previous inspection.
- The inspection was conducted without notice and in accordance with the most recent government guidance related to COVID-19.
- The inspector was asked to report against some of the regulations contained within Parts 3 and 8 of the independent school standards.
- The inspector held discussions with the two headteachers, the designated safeguarding lead, two members of staff and four pupils.
- The inspector reviewed key documents and policies related to safeguarding and the school's risk assessment procedures.
