

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Outcome summary – Malkah Goldberger

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 4 June 2021, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 20 July 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call to the provider. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take within the timescale set out below. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 4 August 2021:

- improve knowledge and understanding of incidents and changes that need to be notified to Ofsted.

On 8 August 2021, the provider responded to the action confirming that they had updated their knowledge and updated their policies and procedures.

We are satisfied the provider has now met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
