

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 21 July 2021, the provider notified us of a serious incident. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant event. On 1 August 2021, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 11 August 2021, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. They had taken swift action to improve the safety on the premises, including the collection procedures to help keep children from risk of harm.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
