

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 17 June 2021, we carried out an inspection and found the childminder was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the childminder was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 6 August 2021, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the childminder had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at the last inspection. We found that the childminder had improved her knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now fully understands her responsibilities. We also found that she demonstrated a clearer understanding of the roles of other agencies in safeguarding children.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
