

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 9 July 2021 and 18 July 2021, the provider notified us about two linked incidents relating to safeguarding. The notifications mean that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

Following a number of update emails from the provider, we carried out a regulatory telephone call on 26 August 2021. We found that the provider had identified a weakness in requirements and had taken action to improve staff's knowledge of safeguarding and whistleblowing procedures. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

## **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
