

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 July 2021, the provider notified us about an incident that had taken place at the setting. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 16 August 2021, we contacted the setting and found that they had taken appropriate action as a result of the incident. However, although not linked to the original notification, we also noted a further weakness. We have issued the provider with a Notice to Improve. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 26 August 2021:

- take action to ensure all staff understand and meet all children's dietary requirements.

On 17 August 2021, we received an action response letter. We found that the Notice to Improve had been met appropriately.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
