

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 June 2021 the provider notified us that they had with a safeguarding incident relating to suitable people working with children. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted of significant events that may affect the ongoing suitability of a provider.

On 6 July, 8 July and 20 August 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone calls to the provider. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. They have reviewed their safeguarding practice and gained a stronger understanding of how to work with other agencies to safeguard children. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. We are satisfied with the action that the provider has taken.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
