

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at:

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 July 2021, we received information that raised concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 30 July 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call to discuss the concerns. We found that the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of a significant events and changes to household members, which is a requirement of their registration.

We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 16 August 2021:

- ensure you know of all matters that require notification to Ofsted and make notification as required. This includes periods when you are not caring for children.

We are satisfied with the response to the action. The provider has now confirmed she is aware of all matters that require notification to Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
