

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 August 2021, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 20 September 2021, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions and learning and development actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the management team had made effective changes to ensure that children are kept safe on the premises. Appropriate hygiene practices had been implemented to promote children's good health. The accident procedure had been updated to ensure that all staff inform parents of any accidents or incidents in a timely manner. Effective arrangements for the key person system are in place. The management team monitor staff's curriculum planning successfully. They provide effective support and training to enable staff to provide quality learning experiences for children.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
