## Summary of key findings

### This provision meets requirements

- Leaders appreciate the importance of working in partnership with parents and with children's teachers. They know to encourage two-way communication about children's welfare needs, interests and experiences.
- Leaders and staff know how to help children feel settled and secure at the club. They have systems to consult children on their individual interests and preferences. Leaders and staff understand how to provide a range of activities and experiences to support children.
- Leaders recognise their responsibility to promote healthy lifestyles for children. They offer children nutritious snacks and regular opportunities for them to play outdoors.
- Leaders know how to evaluate and develop the provision. They understand how to supervise staff and support their professional development. For example, there is an induction process for new staff and a programme of ongoing training.
- Leaders and staff understand how to promote children's good behaviour and to help them be considerate and respectful of others. They recognise the importance of supporting children's understanding of equality and diversity.
- Leaders and staff recognise their responsibility to keep children safe. They can identify the signs of potential abuse and know what to do if they have any child protection concerns. Leaders have robust procedures for recruiting staff, to help ensure that they are suitable to work with children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## Inspection activities

- This was the first routine inspection the setting received since the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic began. The inspector discussed the impact of the pandemic with leaders and has taken that into account in her evaluation of the setting.
- The manager and inspector looked around the areas of the school premises used by the club.
- Leaders discussed with the inspector how they intend to meet the needs of children.
- A sample of documentation was viewed by the inspector, including staff suitability checks and paediatric first-aid certificates.
- The inspector spoke with leaders and staff about how they will safeguard children.
- Leaders spoke to the inspector about how they supervise staff and evaluate the provision to strive for continuous improvement.

We carried out this inspection under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.
