

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

We inspected the setting on 8 October 2021 and found that the provider was meeting the safeguarding and welfare requirements. On 3 November 2021, the provider shared information with us regarding a significant event of a safeguarding nature. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who cares for, or in regular contact with, children on the premises to look after children.

On 11 November 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 25 November 2021:

- ensure that staff deployment and child supervision are effective to keep children safe and to meet their needs.
- ensure that the setting's risk assessments are implemented effectively by all staff, particularly in relation to exit doors, so children do not leave designated areas unsupervised.
- share information effectively with parents, particularly in relation to children's experiences at the setting, so they are enabled to continue children's care at home.

Ofsted has received an appropriate response to the actions to demonstrate that requirements are now met.

## **Publication of compliance action**



We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
