

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 October 2021, we received a concern. We conducted a regulatory visit with the provider where we found that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We have therefore, issued a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. On 12 November 2021 we visited the provider and found they had taken suitable steps to address these concerns. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 11 November 2021:

provide an environment and standard of care that ensures that children always feel safe and secure

gain a secure knowledge and understanding of appropriate ways to manage children's behaviour considering their age and stage of development and their individual needs.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
