

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early year's providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 1 August 2021, the provider notified us that they had taken action to dismiss a member of staff. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On the 11 August the Designated Officer asked the provider to conduct a provider led investigation. The provider fully cooperated with this request. On 20 August 2021, the Designated Officer reviewed the provider led investigation and concluded their investigations into these matters.

Following this, on 2 November 2021 we conducted a regulatory call to the provider.

We found that the provider had taken prompt and effective action to re-train staff on the procedures to follow when an allegation is made against a member of staff.

On 11 October 2021, we received further concerns about this provider.

On 28 October we conducted a regulatory call to the provider and asked them to carry out a provider led investigation into these concerns.

On 8 November we reviewed the provider led investigation. We found that the provider has taken prompt action to re-train staff on the procedures for the safe storage and collection of medication.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider.

The provider will be able to give parents further details about these concerns.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
