

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 26 November 2021, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 7 December 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has held meetings with staff to review staffing arrangements and supervision of children. The provider has also installed an additional lock on an internal door to ensure children cannot access areas of the setting without supervision.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
