Context of the inspection

This inspection took place to evaluate if the boarding provision now meets all of the national minimum standards.

Summary of the progress made in implementing the action plan

Boarders told the inspector that they enjoyed being with their friends in the boarding provision. They say that they feel safe and that they have someone to talk to should they have a concern. There is a real sense of community within the boarding provision, where staff and pupils care for and respect one another.

Since the emergency inspection in June this year, leaders and the proprietor have taken their responsibility to monitor the boarding provision very seriously. They now conduct regular checks to ensure that boarders have suitable and comfortable living conditions.

Leaders have taken action to improve the boarders' living environment. Many of the boarders' beds and mattresses have been replaced. Furthermore, the bedrooms are now benefiting from new wardrobes. The leaders have also reorganised the bedrooms so that the boarders have more living space.

Arrangements to safeguard and promote the welfare of boarders are effective and in line with the school's safeguarding policy. Appropriate safeguarding checks are made on the staff who work in the boarding provision. Staff also receive regular safeguarding training.

Leaders now effectively monitor the boarding provision. This includes visual checks to ensure that fire doors close as required. Leaders' checks also help to ensure that maintenance issues are identified and addressed quickly. Leaders seek boarders' views and then act on them to improve the provision further. This helps senior leaders to continue to monitor boarders' views of, and satisfaction with, the accommodation.
