

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 October 2021, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 16 November 2021, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The report and inspection outcome has now been published. Following the inspection we served a welfare requirements notice on 1 December 2021. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The inspection report sets out the actions that we asked the provider to take.

On 9 December 2021 we visited the provider and setting to monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions were successfully completed. We are satisfied with the actions that the provider has taken.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
