

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 November 2021, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 17 December 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. The focus of the call was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that Ofsted have been provided with the required information to undertake suitability checks on current committee members. The provider has improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities. Arrangements for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities have been improved. We also found that the provider has devised a robust medication policy and ensures that written permission to administer medications is obtained from parents. Partnership working with the linked onsite school has been developed and strategies are now in place to enable staff to exchange information with other professionals involved in children's care and learning.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
