

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 6 December 2021, the provider notified us of an allegation against a staff member. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 12 January 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 1 February 2022:

- ensure there is named person in place to take responsibility in the manager's absence, who is capable of fulfilling this role and responsibility.

On 20 January 2022, the provider responded to the action set. The provider has implemented a series of staff training events. They have ensured that those staff who will take responsibility for managing the setting in the manager's absence are aware of their responsibilities and capable to undertake them. In addition, staff have refreshed their safeguarding and child protection knowledge.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The

provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
