Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The provider understands his role in keeping children safe and protecting them from risk of harm. He ensures that staff have regular training to help them identify the signs of abuse. Staff demonstrate a good understanding of the signs that a child may be at risk of harm.
- The provider is aware of the importance of ensuring that robust recruitment procedures are in place, to ensure people looking after children are suitable.
- The provider recognises his responsibility in making sure that staff have adequate qualifications, training, skills and knowledge and a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities.
- The provider acknowledges the importance of building strong partnerships with parents and other settings that children attend, including the need to share information about children's care needs.
- The provider understands the importance of promoting healthy lifestyle habits, such as the value of eating well-balanced meals, physical activity and enjoying fresh air.
- The provider appreciates the importance of teaching children about good hygiene routines and setting clear boundaries to help guide their behaviour. Staff recognise their role in teaching children to respect and value others.
- The provider knows how to evaluate the practice and seek the views of parents to help identify areas for improvement.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
