

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 01 February 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be Not Met. The inspection report sets out the action the provider was asked to take to meet the requirements.

On 28 February 2022, we carried out a monitoring visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had taken effective action in order to met the actions set. The staff had completed a relevant first aid qualification. Staff have also completed relevant safeguarding training. They are fully aware of signs and symptoms of child protection and in particular the 'prevent duty'. They are also aware of the reporting procedures in order to keep children safe.

We are satisfied that the provider has put systems in place to meet the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.
