Summary of key findings

This provision does not meet requirements

- The provider has not done enough since the last inspection to improve her understanding of child protection issues. In addition, the provider does not understand the requirement to ensure that at least one person has a current paediatric first-aid certificate.
- The provider recognises the importance of teaching children how to be kind, support one another and behave well. She knows how to help children manage risks independently and keep themselves safe.
- The provider understands the importance since the last inspection of working with parents and other professionals to provide a continuity of care and meet children's individual needs. She understands how to provide a warm and welcoming setting where all children are valued and included.
- The provider understands the importance of thorough risk assessments and how to provide a safe environment for children who attend the club.
- The provider knows how to provide a range of activities and opportunities to meet children's individual needs and interests.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What does the setting need to do to improve?

The provision is not meeting requirements and Ofsted intends to take enforcement action.

We will issue a Welfare Requirements Notice requiring the provider to:

Inspection activities

- This was the first routine inspection the provider received since the COVID-19 pandemic began. The inspector discussed the impact of the pandemic with the provider and has taken that into account in their evaluation of the provider.
- The manager and the inspector had a tour of the setting
- The manager explained to the inspector how she organises activities and resources for children who may attend.
- The inspector reviewed documentation, such as evidence of staff suitability and paediatric first-aid qualifications
- Although there were no children in the early age range present at the time of this inspection, there were children present who were over the age of five years.

We carried out this inspection under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
