

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 01 March 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the action the provider was asked to take to meet the requirements.

On 23 March 2022, we carried out a monitoring visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had taken effective action in order to met the actions set. Since the inspection, the childminder has been working on updating her knowledge of prevent duty and safeguarding as well as her assistants. Training has also being completed to bring about improvements to the quality of education. Registers are also being completed. This promotes children safety.

We are satisfied that the provider has put systems in place to meet the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. We will assess the impact of these training events when we complete the re-inspection. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
