

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 24 January 2022, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The provider also notified us of a significant incident. This notification means the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of any significant event.

We contacted the provider and reviewed details of their internal investigation. We found that the provider has implemented staff training, to improve the procedures for identifying and recording accidents and incidents. However, we found that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

We have issued an action for the provider to take.

Action needed by 28 March 2022:

- ensure that staffing arrangements meet the needs of all children and ensure their safety.

On 22 March 2022, the provider responded to the action set. We found the provider had reviewed how staff are deployed and revised the staff rota. The provider has also conducted observations of staff, to ensure that all children's needs are being met and they are safe.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
