

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 March 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 7 April 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. The focus of the call was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider and manager have improved their knowledge of safeguarding procedures and now fully understand their responsibilities. They have taken action to develop staff's knowledge of safeguarding matters, including those who hold lead safeguarding roles. Leaders and staff are clear about the procedures to follow in the event of an allegation or whistleblowing concern.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
